



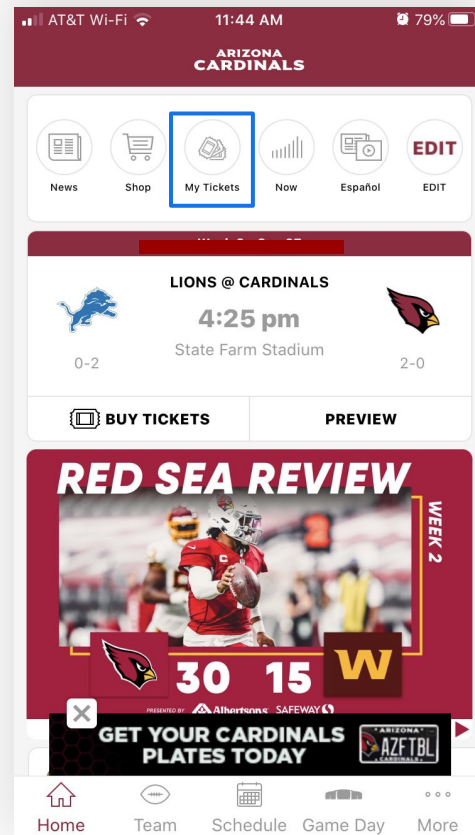
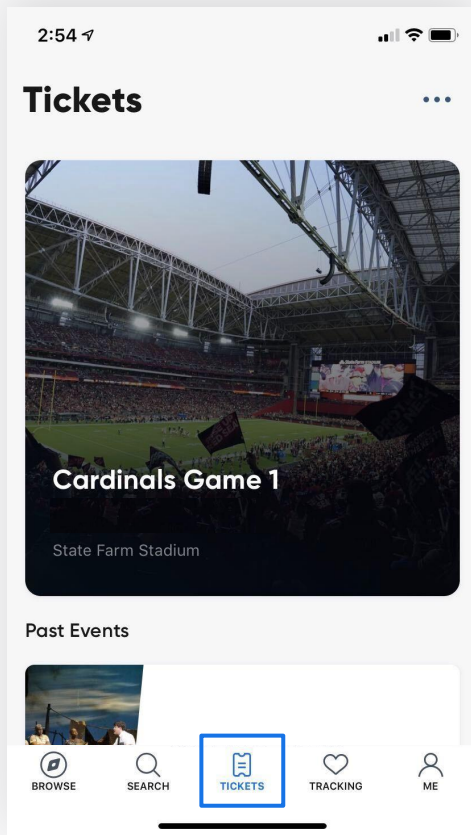

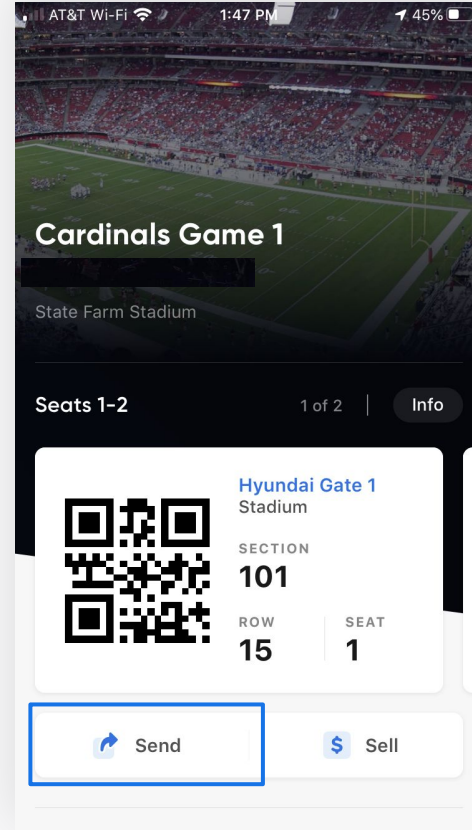


In the SeatGeek app,
Tap **Tickets**

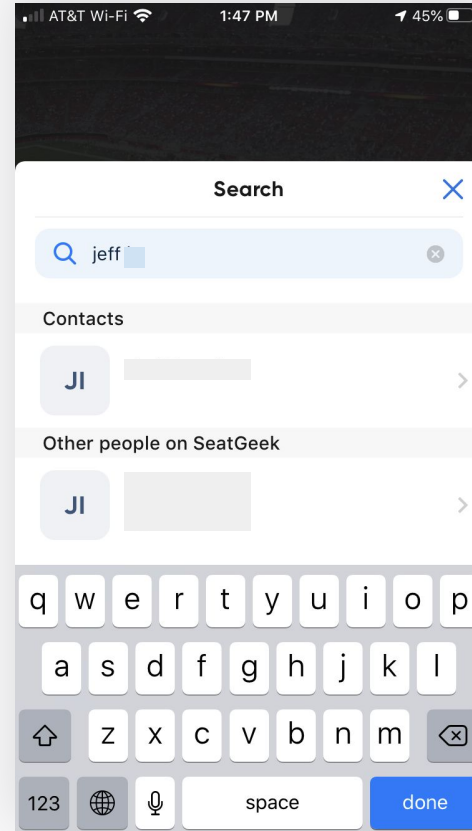
In the Cardinals app,

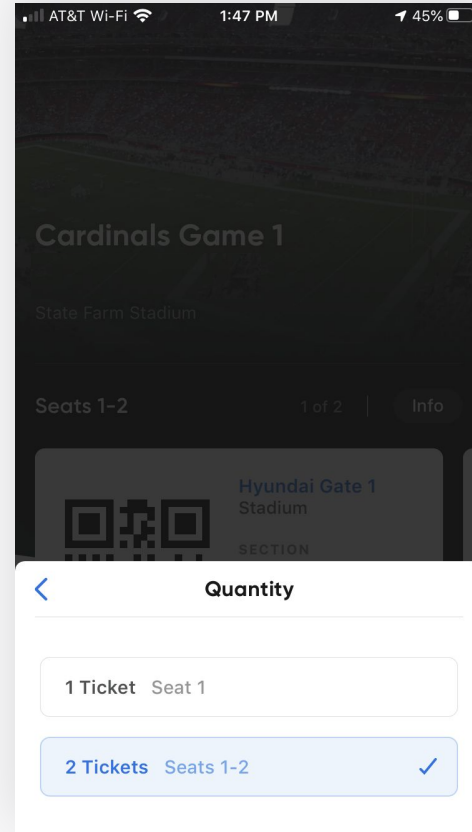

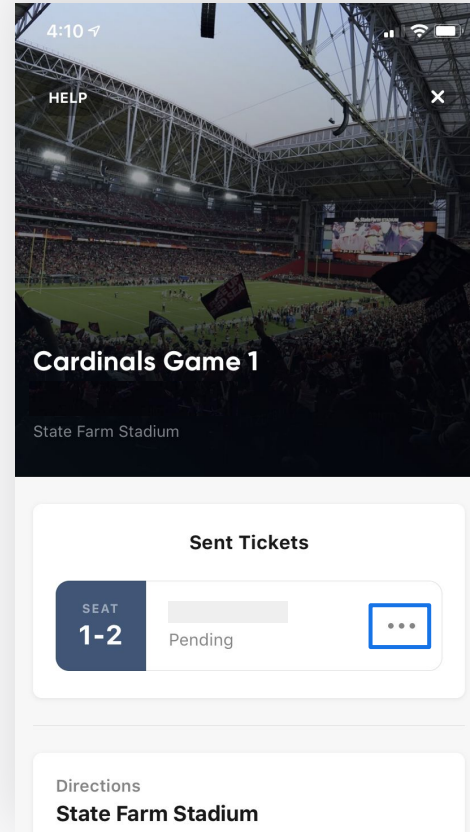
